 - THE LIGHT COLOR IT IS NOT SUITABLE
 - VERY INTENSE LIGHT

GAIA RIVER BANKS by Christos



- EXCEPTIONAL COLOR CHOICE DEFINES USE OF BUILDING
- NO FAÇADE LIGHTING MEANS NO OUTDOOR INSTALLATION
 - THEY CREATE A LAND MARK EASILY

CASTLE by Gerasimos



- COLOR CHOICE EMPHASIZES THE MATERIAL (STONE)
