

CV of Prof. Dr. Hans Poisel (19/02/50)

Poisel Hans, born 1950, received in 1977 his MSc in physics at the Technical University Munich and in 1983 his PhD at the Faculty of Electrophysics. From 1983 he was working for IABG, Ottobrunn on simulation of radar countermeasures. In 1985 he joined MBB in Ottobrunn / Munich, active in development of fiberoptic sensors, leading the fiberoptic gyro project and furthermore coordinating all fiberoptic activities of the company as a whole.

Since 1991 he is professor for Technical Optics and Optical Communication at the University of Applied Sciences Nuremberg, Germany. He published more than 30 contributions devoted to optical properties of Plastic Optical Fibers and their applications in international conferences and journals and holds more than 50 patents in the area of fiberoptics. Currently he is a member of the International Committee for Plastic Optical Fibers (ICPOF) and director of Polymer Optical Fiber Application Center (POF-AC) in Nuernberg. He is a member of OSA, IEEE, VDE and DPG.
